JOHN MORK RETIRES


Our friend and colleague, John Mork, chose to retire on October 1st. John had been employed by Minnehaha County for over 10 years in the position of Park Supervisor.

At Wall Lake, the 80 year old Lyon's Lodge was renovated including a new roof, new electrical service, tuck pointing and repairing loose field stones, finishing and instillation inside, new fixtures, windows and a new cement front entry. In addition, two new picnic shelters were added. John also worked with Sanford Wellness to develop the Wall Lake Triathlon, an annual event utilizing the Park.

The vision of changing a cornfield into Bucher Prairie came to life under John's leadership and dedication. The 20 acre parcel is in the process of being re-created as native prairie. During John's tenure the park office/shop, bathrooms, picnic shelter, bird houses and 1.5 miles of walking trails have been added to the park.
